Health Research Associates (HRA) Membership Program

HRA membership provides the following library services included with annual membership (some fees apply):

- Book borrowing privileges
- Easy online journal article ordering and next day delivery by email or fax
- Annual education and service visit to your office location
- Dana Library electronic newsletter
- Reference and literature search services
- Participation in classes held at Dana Medical Library
- Convenient monthly billing

Who Becomes an HRA Member?

Health Research Associate members include solo healthcare providers, multi-practitioner clinics, public health agencies, healthcare related organizations and private businesses

Examples of member information needs:

- *A physician requests a review article to support a patient medication decision*
- *A public health worker contacts us for pandemic preparedness information*
- *A nurse practitioner requests current review articles on diabetic foot care to prepare for a presentation*
- *A psychologist needs electronic delivery of articles on integration of mental health and medical care*

- Articles only/Loansome Doc option: \$35

Health Organizations & Agencies

- Membership: \$180

Businesses and Corporations

- Membership: \$300
