

MLA Directory of Periodicals via *MLA International Bibliography*

Provides information (e.g., scope, subjects covered, manuscript submission guidelines, circulation information, etc.) on @4,000 journals and series in the *MLA International Bibliography Master List of Periodicals**, and includes many of the periodicals that are indexed in *MLA International Bibliography*. It is no longer available in print, but may be searched online through the *MLA International Bibliography* (via FirstSearch). The electronic *Directory* is updated every 6 months. If you search for the *Directory* in the Library Catalog, you will see an Internet link to *MLA Bibliography* in the catalog record.

Find a Specific Periodical (and its information):

- In the top search box, type the name of the periodical (*omit initial article*).
- In the record field selection box to the right, use the pull-down menu to limit the search to the field **Periodical Title Phrase**. NOTE: if you don't know the complete title, limit the search to the field **Periodical Title**
- Click on the grey "Search" icon, or hit the "Enter" key.

Browse the Title List of Periodicals in the Directory:

- Click on the black-ish button to the right of the field search pull-down menu in the top row. This will bring you to the browse function screen.
 - In the box next to **Browse for:** type the periodical title, or the beginning word/s in the title.
 - Then, in the box next to **Indexed in:** select **Periodical Title Phrase**.
 - Click on the grey "Browse" icon, or hit the "Enter" key. This will bring up a list of periodicals in the alphabet range of the periodical title you typed in the box.
 - To **begin the list in the As**, simply type **a** in the **Browse for:** search box.
 - To move through the list, click on either the **Prev** or **Next** button.
 - Then, click on the link for your desired periodical title.
 - This will return you to the main search screen, with your selected periodical title in the search box.
 - Click on the grey "Search" icon, or hit the "Enter" key.

Find Periodicals in a Subject Area:

- In the top search box, type the subject term
- In the record field selection box to the right, use the pull-down menu to limit the search to the field **Periodical Subject**.
- Click on the grey "Search" icon, or hit the "Enter" key.

Example: search for periodicals covering subjects such as *feminist* or *gender studies*

In the top search box, type in a word such as-> **gender** or **feminist** or **feminists** or **women**.

Or, combine the search terms. In the top search box type --> **gender or feminis* or women***

In the record field selection box to the right, use the pull-down menu to limit the search to the field **Periodical Subject**.

This search will find all periodicals that have the word *gender* or *feminism* or *feminist* or *feminists* or *women* or *women's* in the Subject field of the periodical record. Reminder, the asterisk (*) is a truncation symbol which retrieves the root word and any variant endings.

Browse the List of Periodical Subjects Represented in the Directory:

- Click on the black-ish button to the right of the field search pull-down menu in the top row. This will bring you to the browse function screen.
- In the box next to **Browse for:** type the word, or the beginning of the word (example: fem).
- Then, in the box next to **Indexed in:** select **Periodical Subject Phrase**.
- Click on the grey "Browse" icon, or hit the "Enter" key. This will bring up a list of subject phrases in the alphabet range of the word you typed in the box.
- To **begin the list in the As**, simply type **a** in the **Browse for:** search box.
- To move through the list, click on either the **Prev** or **Next** button.
- Then, click on the link for that subject phrase.
- This will return you to the main search screen, with your selected periodical subject phrase in the search box.
- Click on the grey "Search" icon, or hit the "Enter" key.
- Then, you will get all the records for periodicals which have that as a subject.
- Click on the periodical link to view the information for that periodical.
